Bristol Pegasus Motor Club are pleased to be able to run an AutoSolo at Severn Bridge old services with the kind permission of Gympanzees.

Gympanzees are the new owners of the site and their mission is to deliver multiple fully inclusive leisure facilities that are easily accessible for disabled children, young people and their families.

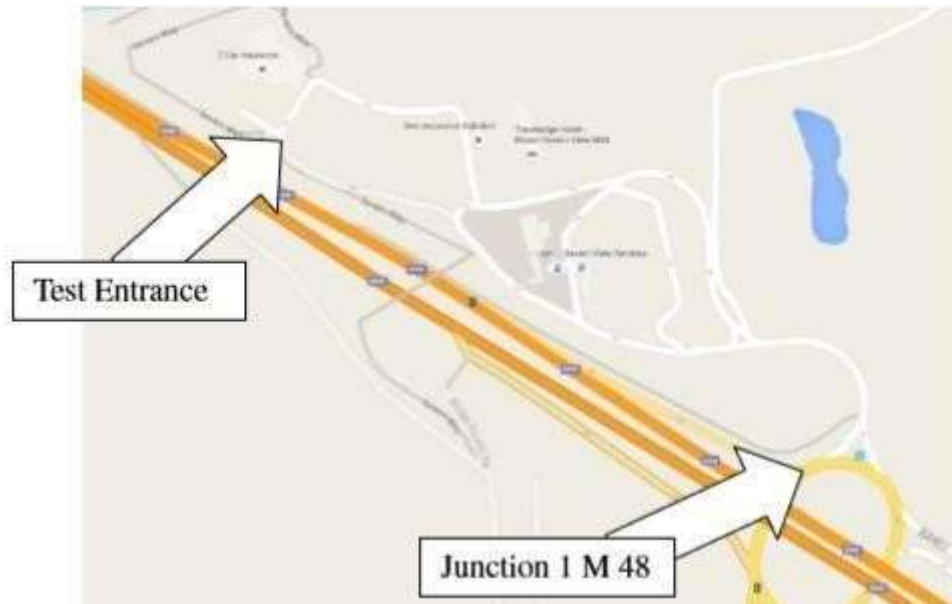
Any profits from the event will be donated to Gympanzees. Gympanzees will be Bristol Pegasus's chosen charity in 2025.

Entries and payments will be taken online or alternatively via paper form and cheque.

There will be physical signing on and scrutineering.

Passenger	Allowed
Driver Minimum Age	<p>Entries can be accepted from drivers who are 14 years or over and do not have a full RTA licence subject to the following:</p> <p>a) The vehicle used must be by definition a touring car;</p> <p>b) Engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc, including a forced induction multiplier of 1.4;</p> <p>c). A front seat passenger must be carried who holds a valid, full RTA licence and is experienced in Autotests or AutoSolos.</p>
Passenger Minimum Age	Any passenger must be at least 12 years old and at least 135cm tall (App6 3.7)

The event will consist of a number of timed all-forward tests. The event takes place on smooth tarmac and should appeal to anyone with a suitable vehicle. Any road car should be suitable.



Supplementary Regulations

1. The Bristol Pegasus Motor Club will organise a Clubmans status AutoSolo on Sunday 6th of April 2025 at Gympanzees, Brightside Park, Severn Bridge, Aust, Bristol, BS35 4BL.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. The following MSUK Permits have been issued; Clubmans AutoSolo permit 202079
4. The Event is open to all fully elected members of the Bristol Pegasus Motor Club and all fully elected members of the following clubs:

Bristol Motor Club, the MGCC (South West Region), Bath MC, Weston Motor Club and Tavern Motor Club.

Championship entrants must be members of Bristol Pegasus Motorclub

Anyone not a member of an eligible club may apply for Bristol Pegasus membership which is free for anyone joining for the first time. <https://bristolpegasus.com/membership/join-our-club/>

5. All entrants in the event must produce a valid membership card for either the promoting club or the invited club.

All competitors including passengers are required to have a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman (or higher grade) competition licence. These may be obtained via the Motorsport UK website. There is no charge for an RS Clubman licence.

All Competitors and passengers must meet the minimum ages set out on the front page of this document. Competitors who do not hold an RTA driving licence must also comply with restrictions set out on the front page of this document regardless of their age.

6. The program of the meeting will be as follows:

Signing on and Scrutineering starts at 9.00 hrs.

Any competitor not signed on by 9.30 hrs may be EXCLUDED. The first car will start at 9.45 hrs.

7. Route

Public roads will not be used to link sections.

The route to be followed on each course will be designated using cones supplemented by yellow cones laid on their side to show which side to pass each marker. Numbered boards will show the order in which each marker is to be passed- Marker cones may be less than 1m tall.

Details of tests will be available for inspection on the official noticeboard.

Start and finish will be marked on each course. Timing will start when the front wheels cross the start line and stop when the front wheels cross the flying finish line. Competitors must then reduce speed and stop at the STOP line to obtain the time and return to the paddock at walking speed. Competitors failing to stop at the STOP line must park and walk back to the control to obtain their time.

A Stop Signal will be displayed if there is an obstruction on the course. A competitor must stop immediately on deployment of the signal and re-run allowed. The Stop Signal will be shown at the drivers briefing.

8. Classes & Vehicles

All vehicles entering the AutoSolo must be driven into the venue be taxed and MOT'd.

Entries of vehicles with four wheel drive will be accepted. .

All vehicles must comply with the MSUK Technical Regulations, including being fitted with an effective silencer.

The Classes for the AutoSolo event will be:

- A. Series Production Cars - Saloon cars up to 1400cc
- B. Series Production Cars - Saloon cars 1401cc to 2000cc
- C. Series Production Cars - Saloon cars over 2000cc in class
- D. Series Production Sports Cars & Specialist Production Cars, including Lotus Elise, VX220, kit cars and all other vehicles not eligible in for classes A, B and C.

A petrol engine car with forced induction, in Class A, or B will move up one capacity class. A rotary engine's capacity will be increased by a multiple of 1.5.

Convertibles & open cars may run with the roof open or closed or with a hardtop fitted according to the driver's wishes. The exception is where a passenger under 16 years old is carried - in this case the roof must be closed or a hardtop fitted. (App. 6, 3.6 & 3.7)

Entries for Hybrid and Electric vehicles will not be accepted.

9. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on the 4th April at 10.30 hrs.

10. This event will be part of 3 Event championship

Points will be given for championship Overall and First in Class, if class has 4 or more entries.

Points will be awarded Overall and in Classes as follows at each event.

Overall 15 for 1st 10 for 2nd 8 for 3rd 6 for 4th 4 for 5th 2 for 6th

Class 5 for 1st 4 for 2nd 3 for 3rd 2 for 4th 1 for 5th

Trophies will be awarded for Overall and Class winners

Championship entry must be registered before first event.

Entry fee is £40 per event or £100 for championship entry

A driver shall only compete in one car.

12. The maximum entry for the meeting is 30. The minimum is 20.

Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting. Entries will be selected at the discretion of the organisers. Entry fees may be refunded if the entry is withdrawn and notice given in writing to the secretary of the meeting, at least 24 hours before the event is due to start.

All officials, and competitors while acting as marshals, will be Judges of Fact to adjudicate on false starts, hitting cones and not following correct route. Their determination is not subject to appeal or protest

14. Tests and Penalties

There will be at least three runs on each course.

Competitors will be required to walk each course before attempting each test.

Drivers who elect to have a passenger in the AutoSolo must have the same passenger throughout the event.

Results will be determined by discarding the worst time recorded on each course.

Timing will be by hand-held stopwatch to the tenth of a second.

Where there is a tie, the result will be determined by the aggregate of the first runs over each course.

Scorecards, which will be the only record of your performance, will be issued.

The following penalties will be applied:

Maximum time is the quickest time in class for that test plus 30 seconds.

a] Failure to signing on – exclusion. b] Taking an incorrect route on any test

Fastest class time + 30 seconds (WT).

[however, returning to the point of departure from the correct route and then completing the correct route, so long as the correction does not impede the next car, will not incur a penalty] c] Striking a direction barrier or test division +5 seconds. d] Striking a cone +5 seconds. e] Missing a run or test Fastest class time + 30 seconds (WT).

f] Reversing back after failing to stop at the stop control – exclusion.

g] Not wearing seatbelts [if fitted] during a test- exclusion.

15. Provisional results will be announced at the end of the event and published by dispatching a copy by email or on request by post within 7 days of the event. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with section ?.

16. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.

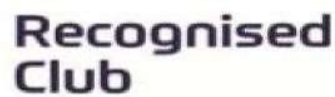
17. All other National Competition Rules of the MSUK apply as written.

 2. To the best of my belief the driver(s) possess(es) the standard of competence necessary for an event of the type to which this entry relates and that the vehicle entered is suitable and roadworthy for the event having regard to the course and the speeds which will be reached.
 3. The use of the vehicle hereby entered is covered by insurance as required by the law which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined by the law.
 4. I understand that should I at any time of this event be suffering from any disability whether permanent or temporary which is likely to affect prejudicially my normal control of the vehicle, I may not take part unless I have declared such disability to the ASN which has, following such declaration, issued a licence which permits me to do so.
 5. Any application form for a Licence which was signed by a person under the age of 18 years was countersigned by that person's parent/legal guardian/guarantor, whose full names and addresses have been given.
 6.
