## Chairman's Chat By Andy Moss

June got off to an excellent start when the Club teamed up with the ACE group for our annual Classic Tour. The event had a good entry of around 35 cars - any more and we would have struggled to accommodate them at the lunchtime stop and the



finish pub. As well as those returning year after year, there always seems to be a few new entrants every year, and the number of club members taking part seems to have steadily increased in recent years. We were very lucky to have good weather, with the event taking place on one of the sunniest days of the year.



The 86 mile route started at BAWA, and this year headed to Wiltshire, with a lunchtime stop at the impressive Caen Hill Locks on the Kennet and Avon canal. Here a total of 29 locks raise the canal some 237 feet over a distance of two miles. As well as the picnic area we made use of on te side of the canal, there is a nice Cafe - well worth a visit if you are in the area. We spoke to a couple of canal boaters who told us it would take them all day

to navigate the flight. The event finished at the Beaufort Arms in Hawkesbury Upton, where as always there was a fundraising raffle and presentation of an award for the "runners choice" to the best car of the day as voted for by the entrants.

As always the Tour raises money for local charities - this year it was supporting Prostrate cancer charities. Initial indications are that the event has raised well over £1100. The amount raised so far will be increased further with money raised from a static display of cars at Rolls-Royce on Thursday the 17th of July - get in touch if you have an interesting car you would like to take. A massive thanks to all involved in organising the event.





On the evening of Monday the 9th our June Club Night ventured south of Bristol, for our Bring your Car night. Nick Wood did an excellent job of organising a new venue for us at the excellent Redhill Village Hall.

As well as ample space for the display of cars we had enough room to run some fun driving tests,

and also had a Barbecue. As with any new venue it is always a little worrying if the evening will be well supported, especially as we were on the other side of Bristol to where most of our club nights are held. There was however no need to worry, as thanks to Nick's efforts we had a superb turnout of cars, and an excellent time was had by all.

Our August event will be another opportunity to get out and about in your car, when we are having a short evening touring assembly organised by Martin Emsley. Next a mention for our visit to Combe on August the 30th. As well as our popular Track Day we will have a car show this year, so this is one not to miss. Around two thirds of the track day places are already sold, so get your entry in as soon as possible - we often see people miss out in the last minute rush for places.



This month we have also had a Pegasus Sprint planning meeting. Things are coming together nicely with all the main officials in place for the meeting. Regs will be issued in early August, and club members will be the first to know when they are available. Some of our invited championships have had very good entries at events this year, so make sure you enter early.

As some of you will know I have owned a Rover P6 since the late 80's, unfortunately it has not seen much use over the last couple of years, so I decided it was time to get it out of hibernation. Having fitted a new battery, it is now running and seems to move and stop under its own steam with no issues.


