Llandow Sprint Saturday 10th May 2014 Report By Andy Moss

Following last years successful sprint at Llandow, we again joined forces with Bristol Motor Club to run the event in 2014. The organisation of the May event normally starts just after Christmas, as well as some regular team members we were pleased to welcome some new faces to the team.



I would take on the secretarial role again, with Bristol member Zoe Tooth joining the team as entries secretary. Nick Wood was again clerk of Course, with Chris Thompson continuing his Clerks training as Assistant Clerk. Glyn Hopkins from BMC would be deputy, but as he now does not live locally he would not be able to get involved in the pre-event planning. Our own Tim Murray would handle Radio Control, with Mark Benstock being chief Marshal. We therefore had our core organising committee arranged with good representation from both clubs.

Early on we found out that Lotus 7 club, who brought large entry of around 30 cars last year, would not be attending as they had decided to concentrate on their own event at Curburough in May. This meant we had to think carefully about whether we would get enough entries. To help with this we were fortunate to gain both the Historic Austin 7 championship and the Downton Engineering Mini Championship.

We were also pleased to be able to welcome the MG Car Club for the second year as an invited Championship. It is nice to continue the long term relationship between the Bristol Clubs and the MGCC, with whom we enjoyed co-promoting the Wessex Sprint with for many years. Entries started to roll in and while the initial response was a little slower than last year, it was soon clear the event was going to be popular again. Entries peaked at 90 which was excellent considering we had lost the Lotus entries. By the day of the event we had a few cars pull out, but we still ran with a very pleasing 83 entries.

As the event got nearer more volunteers were drafted in to help. Barry Green once again agreed to do the very important job of looking after the release button in control and Simon Child volunteered for Startline duties. The startline itself is always a vital part of the event, and an experienced team here is vital to the safe and efficient running of the event. Mark Benstock would also bring his experience here, once he had helped organise the marshals posts. Alison Bisping was a late addition to the startline crew.

We also managed to enlist some enthusiastic youngsters in the Paddock with Sam Thompson and Laura Moss doing an excellent job of rounding up competitors when they were due to run. Back in control, another vital part of the operation was entering times onto the computer to allow us to prepare printed results after the event, and Ben Goodman was doing this for the first time – he did a great job. We were also lucky to have two experienced Club Stewards in Paul Hemming and Dave Cutcliffe.

As always we need the support of quite a few people from outside the clubs to run the event. The rescue unit was supplied by the Midland Hillclimb Championship who have had a long association with us, having provided rescue at Colerne for many years. A team of MSA licensed scrutineers were organised, along with a noise scrutineer. St Johns provided us with an Ambulance and Martin Sullivan was once again our Paramedic. One thing we changed this year was the Timekeeping team – Tony Parker, who has timed the Pegasus Sprint for many years, took on the event, along with Neil Samuel acting as assistant. Tony and Neil are real enthusiasts and do an excellent job.

So, to the event itself. It was great to see a good Pegasus entry – 13 entries being an excellent effort. The weather was showery and a couple of oil spills led to the marshals having to work hard to keep the track safe. Following a short stoppage to clear oil we had a real downpour. Luckily after lunch we had a dry afternoon, but the weather was not quite finished with us yet, as the wind started to get really strong. This had an impact on the timing beams which were suffering from some movement caused by the wind. The main problem was with the light system used to align the car on the start line. To overcome this we switched to a manual alignment "stick" which kept things running smoothly. All the competitors seemed to have a good day and the runs were completed in good time.

Fastest Time of day went to Bradley Hobday in his Jedi, with Andy Laurence picking up the award for Best BMC member. The trophy for best Pegasus member on index went to Martin Watts who recorded a time of 84.51 in his Sylva Riot. Other notable Pegasus performances included first in class awards for Martyn Davies in the Ford Fiesta, Elen Worthington in the Elise and Julian Edmondson in the

Peugeot 106. Pete Goodman and Adrian Jones also took creditable second places in their classes.

Finally, a special mention for all the marshals – as always there would be no event without you. The marshalling duties were split between the organising clubs. It would be nice to have a few more next year, most of the posts can see the whole circuit, which makes



Llandow a good place to marshal. Among our marshals were Ralph Colmar, Liz Moss, Alan Spencer, Simon Moss, Nick Poole and Laurie Eggins – thanks & apologies to anyone I have missed.


