


There will be no club night meeting at BAWA in May but there will be a Treasure Hunt on May 20th - see details below.

On the front cover Duncan is seen competing with his monstrous TVR the most powerful vehicle in the contest; other competitors in the Clubsport competition included Novices Andrew and Keith Firks making their competion debut with their Golf III, Ken and Joe Robson sharing a front wheel drive Range Rover Evoque, Andy Moss with his Marlin, Roland Panes and Stephen Hole sharing another Marlin, Chris Thompson and Nick Wood sharing a Suzuki X90 while Andy Wood was out in his MX5, Philip Buckle brought along his Hillman Imp, and artist film maker Stefan Marjoram drove a Reliant Scimitar SS1.

Alan Spencer scored the lowest points of the day in his quest for the Cotswold Championship. Congratulations to those who won the prizes, as you will see by the comments in the Pit Lane Entry at the back a good time was had by all. Thanks as ever to Tim, Mal and Pete for their roles in organising the event and to Donny, Carlie and Liz for marshalling the tests.







Colin Ladd Remembered

Colin Ladd, who died earlier this year, will be best known to BPMC members for competing in the Cross Trophy and other local trials in a Citroen AX.

Colin was, in fact, much more of a two wheel enthusiast, following his father who was an active member of the Knowle and District MC&LCC before the war. He competed in trials in the 60's and 70's using a Greeves Scottish he bought in 1968 and which he still used for pottering around Gloucestershire until last year.

He was also a keen road rider on BSA and BMW bikes, before family commitments dictated a change to a car. Later he was a pioneer "born again" motorcyclist, his Honda Blackbird being one of the first in the UK.



For his road cars Colin chose Audi, with a succession of 100 and A6 models culminating in an A8. He had actually bought the AX as a run around whilst sourcing his A8 and decided, on something of an impulse, to try it in trails.

This led to a growing enthusiasm for this type of motorsport and he continued to compete regularly despite the deterioration in his health, his last his last major event being the Lands' End, which he completed successfully in class O.

Continuing the family tradition, his son Robert is planning to

enter this event next year on Colin's other bike, an ex MOD Harley Davidson. He was a true enthusiast and competitor who will be greatly missed.
