Introduction

The event will consist of a number of fun special tests. The event takes place on smooth tarmac, the event should appeal to anyone who would like a bit of fun in their car. Any road car should be suitable. No competition licence is needed. The winner is the person who picks up the least amount of penalties for each type of test meaning that it is all about the skill of the driver.

Supplementary Regulations

1. The Bristol Pegasus Motor Club will organise a Gymkhana under a Certificate of Exception on Sunday 21st of September 2014 at Rolls Royce plc, Gypsy Patch Lane, Patchway, Filton, Bristol BS34 6QD.

Directions from Gypsy Patch Lane:

- turn into the 'Concrete Road' off the Mini roundabout at Gypsy Patch Lane
- turn Right at barrier into Car Park, go as far as you can.
- turn Left then just follow the road up behind test beds and Patchway Station, you will eventually come to a big car park

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. The following MSA Permits have been issued. Certificate of Exemption 85283.

4. The Event is open to all fully elected members of the Bristol Pegasus Motor Club and all fully elected members of the following clubs:
MGCC (South West Region) and Tavern Motor Club

5. All entrants in the event must produce a valid membership card for either the promoting club or the invited club. No competition licence is required for this event.

6. The programme of the meeting will be as follows: Signing on and Scrutineering starts at 1 pm.

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Any competitor not signed on by 2 pm may be EXCLUDED. The first car will start at 2 pm.

7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be a number of special 6 tests on private land. Each competitor will have at least two attempts at each test. The best score for each test will count. Details of the tests will be explained at the start of each one. A signed on front seat passengers may be carried. The entry may be split into groups starting on different sections.

8. The event will consist of a single class

Entries of vehicles with four wheel drive will be accepted. Commercial type vehicles may compete. Three wheel vehicles only accepted at organiser's discretion. All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations, and must be fitted with an effective silencer.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:

- 1st overall
- 2nd overall
- 3rd overall

10. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on the day of the event at 1.45 pm.

The entry fee is £5.

All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to Bristol Pegasus Motor Club.

Entries will be selected at the discretion of the organisers. Entry fees may be refunded if the entry is withdrawn and notice given in writing to the secretary of the meeting, at least 24 hours before the event is due to start.

14. Provisional results will be published by despatching a copy by email or on request by post within 7 days of the event.

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15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C 5.1 to 5.7.
16. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.
17. Marks will be awarded for completion of each section correctly as appropriate. Details of marking and penalties will be explained at start of each test.
18. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
19. Awards will be presented at the BPMC Annual General Meeting to be held on Monday 8th December 2014. If unable to attend the competitor is to make arrangements for award collection.

 5. Any application form for a Licence which was signed by a person under the age of 18 years was countersigned by that person's parent/legal guardian/guarantor, whose full names and addresses have been given.
 6. If I am the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor of the driver I understand that I shall have the right to be present during any procedure being carried out under the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and the General Regulations of the MSA. As the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor I confirm that I have acquainted myself with the MSA General Regulations, agree to pay any appropriate charges and fees pursuant to those Regulations (to include any appendices thereto) and hereby agree to be bound by those Regulations and submit myself without reserve to the consequences resulting from those Regulations (and any subsequent alteration thereof). Further, I agree to pay as liquidated damages any fines imposed upon me up to the maxima set out in Part 3, Appendix 1.
