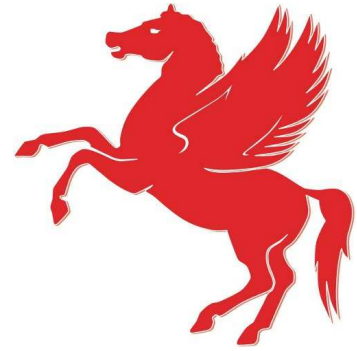


BRISTOL PEGASUS MOTOR CLUB
NAVIGATIONAL SCATTER 27th NOVEMBER 2009
SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS



1. The Bristol Pegasus Motor Club will promote a Clubsport Navigational Scatter on Friday 27th November 2009.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising Club may issue for this event.
3. MSA Permit number 55427 has been issued
4. The event is open to all members of the promoting club and members of the following invited clubs: Bristol Motor Club; Bristol University Motor Club; Bath Motor Club.
5. The start venue will be the car park on Wickwar Road, Chipping Sodbury, OS Landranger Map 172 Grid Ref. 726/824, and the event will take place entirely on map 172. It should be possible to visit 75% of the points without covering more than 55 miles. The finish will be advised in the final instructions, but will be before midnight.
6. Signing-on will be from 18:45. Route information will be handed out at 19:30.
7. Each crew will comprise driver and navigator only, both of whom must sign the official signing-on sheet at the start and produce their Club membership cards.
8. Minimum equipment required: OS Landranger Map Sheet 172, (current edition); collapsible map-board; map-reading light; torch; pencils & eraser; romer (recommended).
9. There will be no classes.
10. The event is a round of the BPMC Clubman's championship.

12. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on 27th November 2009 at 1930. Entries should be made on the Entry Form attached. You may either post it to the Event Secretary, or bring it with you on the night. There is no entry fee, but if you require insurance cover under the club scheme, a cheque will be required at signing-on (see paras.18 & 21 of these SRs).
13. Identification will be by numbered route cards.
14. Timing, to the previous whole minute, will be by the Clerk of the Course's watch set by atomic clock.
15. No more than four forward-facing lights may be used (not including sidelights). **No** spotlamps may be used. Any competitor in contravention of these requirements **will be excluded**.
16. Please remember this event takes place in the early evening, and you should drive with consideration for other road users. All villages must be treated as quiet zones. Conduct liable to bring motorsport into disrepute **will result in exclusion**.
17. The organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel, postpone or delete all or part of the event due to unforeseen circumstances.

18. You must ensure that you and your vehicle are covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act. See paragraph 24 for insurance which can be arranged on your behalf. **If you have extended your own private Motor Insurance please bring details to signing on.**

19. Scoring will be as follows:

Each Type A route check visited (grid references) 10 points (70% of RCs)

Each Type B route check visited (navigation) 20 points (30% of RCs)

A maximum of 75% of the route checks will count towards the final score. If more than 75% are visited then the best 75% will count.

The winners will be the crew with the highest score.

Ties will be resolved as follows:

- a) The crew with the most B type route checks
- b) Any other method the organisers can think of

20. Awards will be made as follows:

a) 1st overall driver and navigator

b) 2nd Overall driver and navigator (subject to 5 starters)

c) 3rd Overall driver and navigator (subject to 9 starters)

21. The club has applied to Chaucer Insurance for a Blanket Cover Note under its Motor Sports Clubs Scheme. This will provide competitors with the Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements.

The basic rate before loadings will be £15.00 per car and **cheques should be made payable to "Bristol Pegasus Motor Club"**.

Automatic acceptance will be given to all competitors meeting the following criteria:

- Age 19 years of age or over
- Has held a full licence for a minimum of 6 months
- Has less than 9 points of their licence
- Has had 2 or less fault claims in the last 3 years

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25

Anyone falling outside these limits should talk directly to Samantha Bartlett at Chaucer by calling 0115 985 0165 at least one working day prior to the event commencing – only in extreme conditions will they refuse insurance or a load premium.
