- The M.G. Car Club (South West) Centre will organise a National B Status Speed Hill Climb on Saturday 11th September 2010 at Wiscombe Park, Honiton, Devon.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. M.S.A. Permit Number 58690
- 4. The event is open to:
 - (a) All fully elected members of the MG Car Club
 - (b) Members of the: Ariel Atom Owners Club, Austin Healey Club Healeysport, Bristol Pegasus Motor Club, Bristol Motor Club, Buckler Register, Lotus Seven Club, Reliant Scimitar & Sabre Owners Club Ltd, Torbay Motor Club, Triumph TR Register, The 500 Owners Association, Woolbridge Motor Club, Vintage Sports Car Club and Volvo Owners Club.
- 5. All Competitors and drivers must produce a valid competition licence and Club Membership Card.
- 6. The event is a round of the: MGCC SW Centre Drivers Championship,
 Luffield Cars MG Speed Championship (CHS 2010-036): Lotus 7 Speed Championship (CHS 2010-057 (D)):
 Austin Healey Club Healeysport Speed Championship (CHS 2010-050): Torbay Speed Championship (CHS 2010-051 (D))

- 8. The length of the course is 900m (1000yds) and consists of one sharp left hander at the start, a sweeping gradient leading to several fast bends which end with a RH hairpin leading onto a straight, ending with a LH hairpin with the finish just beyond. The average gradient is 1 in 13.6 and the steepest part is 1 in 6.9. The surface is sealed tarmacadam.
- 9. The event will consist of classes as follows:
 - Class 1. (a) Vintage cars, sports saloons and touring cars pre 1931.
 - (b) Sports saloons and touring cars pre 1941.

The above may be sub-divided by engine capacity subject to numbers entered.

- 16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with GR C5 The appropriate fee should accompany each protest.
- 17. Cars will be directed to and positioned on the start line by the Start line official. Cars will start singly from a standing start with the car cutting a light beam at the start and will end by the car cutting a similar beam at the finish. The finish will be indicated by a banner over the finish line. Timing struts must be fitted in accordance with GR S10.9
- 18. Practice: All competitors will have the opportunity of two runs after walking the course under official control which must be completed by 08 30hrs. If a competitor has competed at the previous weekend meeting he will not be required, but is advised to walk the hill and may sign a declaration at signing on.
- 19. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will not be provided by the organisers. Numbers be in accordance with GR S9.2.5
- **20.** COMPETITORS ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO:
 - 1. GR. S10.10 with regard to Classes A1 E3
 - 2. GR. S9.2.1 (page 326) and in particular the requirement for flame- resistant gloves.
- 21. Conformity:

All vehicles shall conform to GR J 5.17 concerning silencing Chart 24 Section G (110/108dB(A) at 0.5m)

All cars with engines running on diesel fuel will be subject to a 30% capacity reduction e.g. 2000cc diesel engines equate to 1400cc.

Non-diesel forced induction equivalent will be 140% e.g. 1000cc forced induction engines equate to 1400cc. (Except Class 2 as stated)

 $Cars\ using\ non\ pump\ fuel\ must\ display\ a\ 75mm\ (\ 3\ inch\)\ diameter\ `Day\ Glo'\ orange\ disc\ on\ a\ contrasting\ background\ affixed\ to\ their\ competition\ number\ on\ both\ sides\ GR\ J5.\ 13.6$

22. All other general regulation of the M.S.A. apply as written except for the following which are modified. S 9.2.3. No driver may drive more than one car in any class of more than 2 cars in the whole competition. No car may be driven by more than two drivers.

Each driver will be given a minimum of two runs in the same car in each class entered, the faster run to count for the results. If time permits additional timed runs may be offered but will not count towards awards.
